





The University of Winnipeg Coat of Arms

The University of Winnipeg was founded in 1967. The elements found within the Coat of Arms of the University during the academic session of 1972-73. The elements found within the Coat of Arms are: a shield divided into four quarters. The quarters contain: a book, a quill pen, a lamp of knowledge, and a scale of justice. The shield is supported by two figures: a Native American and a European. Above the shield is a crest consisting of a book and a quill pen. The motto of the University is: "In the heart of the North, we seek the truth." The coat of arms is surrounded by a border containing the name of the University in both English and French: "The University of Winnipeg / L'Université de Winnipeg".
