Improving upon our legacy as a University means investing in what matters the most to the academics, researchers, and students who work and study at the heart of our campus.



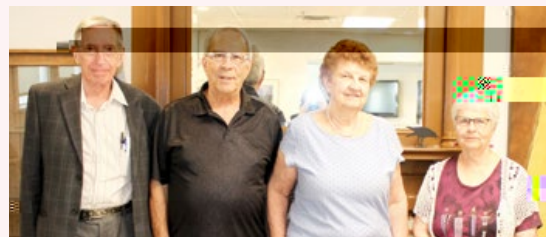
Investing in The University of Winnipeg Foundation Endowment Fund

The Foundation's investment policies call for a prudent, diversified portfolio of Canadian and foreign equities to prescribed limits. Equities are not to exceed 70% of the portfolio. The Foundation's investment policies are designed to provide consistent long-term growth while protecting the purchasing power of the Endowment Fund. The Foundation does not invest in speculative or high-risk investments. In 2021, the main portfolio manager stewarding the Foundation's investments became a signatory of the Net Zero Asset Manager Initiative (NZAM). This initiative "is an international group of asset managers committed to supporting the goal of net zero greenhouse gas emissions

Remembering Dr. John Bulman, CM

On June 15th, 2023, Dr. W. John Bulman passed away at the age of 94. An incredibly kind and generous man whose relationship with The University of Winnipeg spanned over 40 years, Dr. Bulman held many titles as a member of our community—including Chancellor from 1984 to 1996, Board of Regents member from 1967 to 1982, and secretary for The University of Winnipeg Foundation's Board of Directors—a position he would serve from 2003

when the Board was established until retiring in 2020.

Dr. Bulman helped oversee much of the progress made on our campus in the years after the charter was signed. As Regent and Chancellor, he supported the expansion of the university's academic programs, our spaces on campus, and the growing number of students choosing to pursue their post-secondary education at UWinnipeg. During his tenure with the Foundation, Dr. Bulman also Co-Chaired the Planned Giving Committee and was instrumental in the creation of the Legacy Circle, a community of donors whose planned gifts will help support funding for the University's priorities and awards program for the next generation of students and scholars.

In addition to his efforts as a volunteer, Dr. Bulman and his wife Laureen were avid donors who sponsored numerous student awards and campaigns over the years. What began in 1985 with an undesignated gift to the "area of greatest need", the couple would go on to direct much of their charity to the John Bulman Collegiate Entrance Scholarship and the Chancellor W. John A. Bulman Scholarship in 2007—awards established by their close friends and colleagues to honour their longstanding commitment to the university. In recognition of his efforts as Chancellor, the area beneath Riddell Hall was renamed in order to honour Dr. Bulman's leadership and the support he supported over the years. The Bulman Student Centre has become a much-loved space and stage where community members and students alike can come to relax, learn, and perform.
