In 2005 – 2006, The University of Winnipeg Foundation received donations of over \$1,923,295 to create new endowment funds.

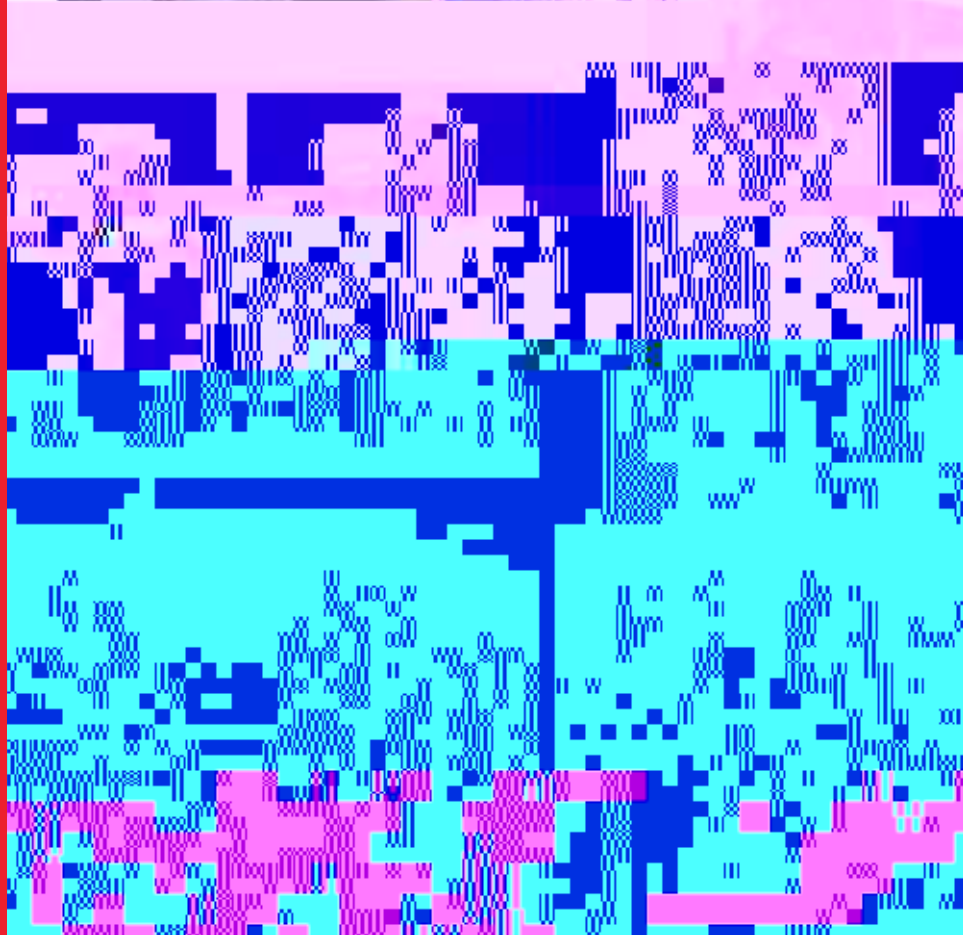
Guiding Legacies Through Endowed Funds

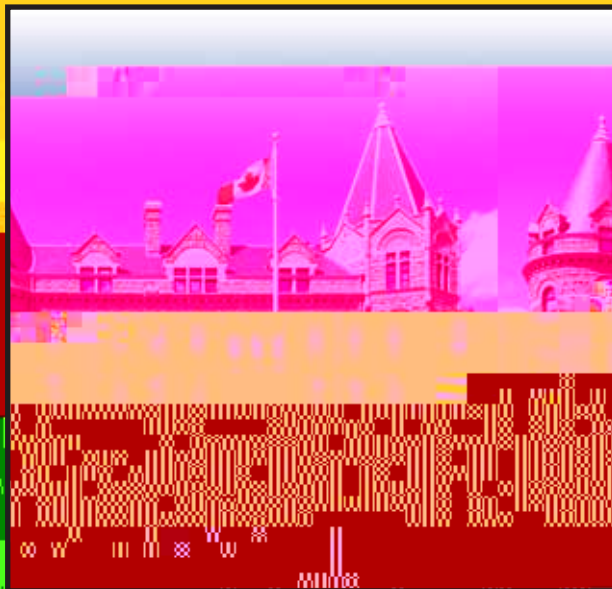
